The extra-curricular activities are conducted over two sessions every Wednesday afternoon. All students are required to participate in one activity during session A (13:00-14:00), while session B (14:15-15:15) is optional. There are some courses with ☆, which we encourage students to participate in the same course for three consecutive academic terms throughout the year, help students achieve better learning results. Parents and their children are kindly asked to read the course materials for the multiple intelligence courses and nominate which activities they would like to attend on Wednesday afternoons.

Notes:

1. Third Term Multiple Intelligence Course will start on 18th March, 2026. Students must attend **at least one multi-intelligence course**.
2. Students are required to gather in the school playground after lunch before going to the activity venue. When they have finished with the class, they have to go back to school with the team.
3. Please note that the venue stated in the notice is the main place for the class. For reasons such as weather or course layout, the venue will be co-ordinated as required.
4. Students must attend every extra-curricular activity lesson. **Unexcused absences will be deemed as absenteeism.**
5. Students who are recommended by teachers or tutors will have priority access. In the case of over-subscription, lots will be drawn to determine the successful applicants. Courses will be cancelled if the number of applications is below the minimum required. Applicants of any cancelled courses will have priority to enroll in their next choice.
6. The course will be randomly assigned by the computer system if students have not filled in the second or third choice.
7. **No changes can be made once the enrolment is confirmed. No refund for the paid fees.**
8. All course fees are used to hire tutors and purchase activity materials.
9. School activities have gradually returned to normal after the epidemic. More options of courses have added to explore students' interests and potential. The courses are largely subsidised by the school. **Students who receive a full grant under the Student Financial Assistance Schemes (SFO) can receive half of the subsidy for each term.** The amount will be refunded to parents at the end of the school year. **Students must pay the full fee first.** If you have any difficulties, please contact the class teacher.
