Class and Exam Arrangements after Chinese New Year Holidays

Dear Parents,

Face-to-Face Class Arrangements

The EDB has announced that more students can be arranged to return to campuses on a half-day basis in accordance with school-based circumstances after the schools' Chinese New Year's holidays, with the number of students capped at one-third of the total number of students of the schools. Our school will arrange students of different levels to have face-to-face classes on different days, whereas the other levels will continue to have online lessons via Zoom.

All the face-to-face and online lessons will follow the Zoom timetable, except that we will arrange a class teacher period for the face-to-face classes from 9:15-9:30. Therefore, students need to arrive at school before 9:15a.m. Parents of P1 to P4 students need to come to school on Fridays (26/2 and 5/3) to hand in and collect homework as usual.

Second Term Exams Arrangements

To better facilitate students' Second Term Exams, separate exam weeks for different levels will be arranged. Two selected levels will come to school for their given exam week to have face-to-face lessons and exams. The other levels will have online lessons via Zoom.

Notes About Taking the Exams

A. Exam venue discipline

- 1. The students must take the exams according to the timetable set by the school.
- 2. No extra time will be given if students arrive at school late without a valid reason.
- 3. Early leave will not be permitted if no special reasons are given.
- 4. Students will sit according to their class numbers. The seats will be rearranged in single rows.
- 5. Students are prohibited from talking with their classmates during exams. If students have any questions, they can ask their teachers.

B. Makeup exams and checking of exam papers

- Absentees will take makeup exams within the three consecutive school days after the exam.
 Marks will not be deducted for taking makeup exams. If students cannot take the exams or the makeup exams on the dates designated by the school, their cumulative year-end results will be calculated using only the other two terms' results.
- 2. Term two exam papers will be checked on 12 April and 13 April (P1 & P2). After checking the exam papers, P1 to P5 students will take their exam papers home for their parents to sign. The signed exam papers then need to be returned to the relevant subject teachers the next day.

C. Arrangements in case of bad weather

If the Education Bureau announces that all primary schools will be closed in the morning due to a typhoon or other bad weather, the exams will be postponed to the next school day.

Accessing 17-18 and 18-19 Previous Exam Papers on eClass

The previous years' exam papers and suggested answers for the Chinese Reading (and Listening), General English and Writing, Mathematics and General Studies have been uploaded onto eClass. Parents and students can download the previous exam papers by following the steps below:

- 1. Log onto eClass with students' identity number (s0XXXX).
- 2. Click 'eng' in the top right-hand corner of the page.
- 3. Enter 'Classroom Area'
- 4. Click 'Shared Files'
- 5. Click 'Public Files'
- 6. Click 'Past Papers.
- 7. Choose 'English', 'Chinese', 'Mathematics' or 'General Studies' folder.
- 8. Click on the past exam papers that you want to read (PDF format).

Since the syllabus may not be the same every year, the past papers on eClass may not cover the exact same material.
